The best poker hand:

The best Poker Hand will be judged according to the following: from Best to Worst. Royal Flush; Five of a Kind; Straight Flush; Four of a Kind; Full House; Flush; Straight; Three of a Kind; Two Pair; One Pair; Spades, Hearts, Diamonds, and then Clubs.

Since several decks are used, a tie hand is possible. In the case of a tie hand, the two participants will be dealt a new hand by an independent third party. Additional rules required "On the Spot" will be determined by the officials on hand. All decisions by these officials will be final. If "5 of a kind" should occur it would be considered to be ranked between a Royal Flush and a straight.

SAFETY RULES

In an effort of maintaining safety, and in the interest of keeping poker runs safe for everyone, the rules have been established by our safety committee. Failure to comply with our rules will result in disqualification from the poker run.

- A Poker Run is not a race. At no time during a poker run will racing occur between/among participants. Please abide by all speed limits.
- Absolutely <u>no alcohol</u> consumed by anyone on board or visible on board, during the day of the event until the boat is tied up for the evening following the event.
- Every boat must comply with current USCG/ CCG construction and <u>safety requirements</u> and carry the required on-board safety equipment.
- USCG/ CCG <u>approved life vests</u> must be worn by everyone on board at all times when the boat is in motion during the event.
- <u>Ignition safety tethers</u> must be in working condition and suitably attached while the boat is in motion.

- Always respect designated speed limits and sound restriction laws.
- Be aware of all diver sites and watch for dive buoys.
- The <u>law enforcement will use their lights only</u> when escorting the poker run fleet. Under other circumstances, boaters will need to stop and report to them.
- PRA recommends and encourages poker runners to have a <u>functioning radio</u> communication system on board in order to be reached at all times.

Rules will be reviewed at the Driver's Safety Meeting Saturday morning. A more complete list of rules is available in the APRA Official Rule Book that is available at registration.

FLAGS

As part of the safety criteria standard flag colors will be used for all poker runs, as follows:

Red Signifies Stop

Black Signifies Accident or Course Closed

Yellow Signifies Caution Green Signifies Go

Diver Flag Signifies Divers Below

Alternate Flags

Orange Signifies Marshal Boat
Purple Signifies Disqualification

<u>Directions for Poker Run Registrants as they arrive in Hawkesbury.</u>

Arriving via Hwy 50 or 148 across the bridge.

Proceed on to Blvd du Chenail continue on to McGill St, to Hwy 17, I take 17 east towards Montreal, approximately 1 km, 1st intersection traffic light, turn Left on Cameron ST. Continue to Golden Anchor Warehouse, **923 Cameron St**, **Hawkesbury**, ON K6A 2B8 where you will receive directions and register for the Poker Run.

Arriving from Montreal on Hwy 17,

Turn right on Cameron ST., continue to Golden Anchor Warehouse, **923 Cameron St**, **Hawkesbury**, ON K6A 2B8, where you will receive directions and register for the Poker Run.

Arriving from Hwy 34:




Arriving on Hwy 17 from Ottawa,
